

Biography Vicente Olmos

Vicente Olmos was born in Paiporta (Valencia). He graduated on trumpet at the Conservatory of Valencia with Professor D. Leopoldo Vidal, obtaining the highest qualifications. He later continued his studies with Pierre Thibaud (profesor Conservatory of Paris).

He has worked with practically all the orchestras of Spain, collaborating as guest principal on many occasions with, for example, the Orchestra of Valencia or the Chamber Orchestra "Reina Sofía" etc. He has also collaborated with to European orchestras such as the prestigious Chamber Orchestra "Moscow Virtuosi" as first trumpet.

As a soloist, he recorded with the pianist Itziar Barredo, the album "PLAYING OPERA" (Trumpet & Piano) is an immersion in the world of opera and his goal is to make the opera known and closer to the public but from the point of instrumental view through fantasies made by JB ARBAN.

His discography has been applauded and awarded by national and international critics, being awarded the **SILVER MEDAL** and there cognition as Outstanding Work in the **Global Music Awards in California - USA, in the category of "Classical Music"**.

His repertoire is extensive and varied, covering all periods, from the Renaissance to contemporary music.

He has been invited to teach advanced courses, lectures and lectures in various parts of the Spanish geography, highlighting those made for the conservatories of Bilbao, Gijón, Logroño, Algarve (Portugal), Lisboa, UNED and the University of Deusto (Vizcaya) among others.

He has been laureate in the International Trumpet Competition in Geneva (Switzerland). He is a member of the "**ENRIQUE CRESPOBRASS-ENSEMBLE**" of the brass quintet "**EUSKALDUNA BRASS**" and is a founding member of the vocal and instrumental group "**TERZETTO XXI**" (soprano, trumpet and organ).

After having held the position of principal trumpet of the Principality of Asturias Symphony Orchestra, he is currently principal trumpet of the Bilbao Symphony Orchestra.
